Focus Visit Programs

Rainforest Adventures Gallery Play: Rainforest Adventures Suggested Grades K-5

Visit the Center's newest exhibit gallery and learn about Rainforests and their importance in our every day lives. K-1 will learn about the layers of the rainforest, animals and plants and their adaptations. 2-3rd graders will explore the water cycle and how water is a precious resource. 4-5th graders will learn about the ecosystem of the rainforest and threats to its existence.

Body Basics With Stuffee Gallery Play: Fantastic You Suggested Grades Pre-5

Participate in an interactive lesson with Stuffee, our seven-foot, blue-haired friend, and discover the wonders of the human body from the inside-out. After exploring the digestive system, circulatory system, and respiratory system, learn more about the amazing human machine with a visit to our Fantastic You! gallery.

Money Matters Gallery Play: Your Town Suggested Grades 3-5

Participate in an interactive focus visit about money matters. Make decisions about how to save, spend or share your earnings. Learn how the exchange of goods and services fuels an economy, and pretend to be a consumer or a producer as you explore our Your Town gallery.

Living Legacies Gallery Play: Hawaiian Rainbows Suggested Grades K-4

Imagine you were immigrating to Hawaii during the plantation days and starting a new life in another country. What would you take with you, and what would you leave behind? In this focus visit, students will explore the stories and customs of China, Portugal, Japan, Korea, and the Philippines, then make critical decisions in order to honor and preserve their cultural traditions.

Over the Rainbow to China Gallery Play: Your Rainbow World Suggested Grades Pre-3

In this focus visit, children will participate in a group lesson on Chinese kites; folklore, history, artistry, and its cultural significance in China through the examination of authentic kites from China. Children will also have the opportunity to paint a butterfly kite for The Double Ninth Festival.
