

TIE DYE BUTTERFLIES

Investigate what colors you can create!

Big Idea:

Practice a variety of fine motor skills as you explore creating and mixing colors.

Materials:

- Paper towel/coffee filters
- Scissors
- Clothes pin
- Eyedropper
- Jars of water
- Food coloring or watercolors

Directions:

- 1. Talk about attributes of butterflies. What are the shapes and sizes of the wings? What does their body look like?
- 2. Fold a paper towel in half. Cut away from the crease as you cut the shape of the two butterfly wings.
- 3. Color your water using the food coloring. Use the eyedropper to transfer the colored water onto your butterfly wings.
- 4. Pinch your butterfly in the middle and secure with a clothespin.
